CONCLUSION

The plasma hyaluronan levels determined by the enzyme-linked anti-biotinylated hyaluronic acid assay were within normal range and did not correlate significantly with both immunosuppressive drug levels as well as graft status. However, good maintenance at therapeutic levels of immunosuppressive drugs and keeping hyaluronan in the normal range were good predictors of successful renal grafting.
