CONSENT FORM TO PARTICIPATE IN A RESEARCH STUDY CHIANG MAI UNIVERSITY PROCESS OF COPING WITH CHILDBIRTH AMONG THAI WOMEN

EXPLANATION TO PROPOSED PARTICIPANTS

A. PURPOSE AND BACKGROUND

Usa Chuahorm, a doctoral student of the Faculty of Nursing, Chiang Mai University, is conducting a study supervised by Associate Professor Dr. Kasara Sripichyakan, aiming to understand about the coping process of Thai women during their childbirth experiences. Because I am going to give birth at this hospital, I am being asked to participate in this study.

B. PROCEDURES

If I agree to be in this study, the following will happen:

<u>If I am in the early phase of childbirth</u>, I will be observed during childbirth, then I will be interviewed as the procedures above.

If I am in postpartum period:

- 1. I will be asked about my feelings and thoughts about this childbirth in the hospital or at my home after birth whenever I am healthy and ready to talk. It will take time about 45 to 90 minutes. I will be interviewed twice to four times.
- 2. The interview will be audiotape-recorded if I agree.
- 3. I may be asked about the conclusion of interview later if I agree.

C. RISKS OR DISCOMFORTS

- 1. I may feel uncomfortable to talk about my childbirth experience. I can choose a quiet and private place for the interview and I am free to stop the interview at any time or to decline to answer any questions.
- 2. Confidentiality: All information in my interview and written document will be kept as confidential as possible. No individual name or identification will be used in any reports or publications resulting from this study. Direct quotes from my interview(s) may be used in published reports, but all personally identifying information will be removed from these quotes. All information will be kept in a safe place at all times and will be ruined within five years. Only the researchers will have access to the files and audiotapes.

D. BENEFITS

There are no direct benefits to me from participating in the study. However, outcomes of the study will add more knowledge to the midwifery practice about Thai women's childbirth. This may lead to more appropriate care during childbirth that can better serve the needs of Thai women and families. Other benefits from the research results will be under the rule of Chiang Mai University.

F. COSTS/FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

There are no costs to me for participating in this study. I will receive a baby's classical music compact disc for baby for all interviews and can reimburse for transportation.

- (e) From your own experience, what would you tell other women about childbirth? Follow-up Questions
- (a) What did you feel about this?
- (b) Then what did you do?
- (c) What happened next?
- (d) Could you describe more about...?
- (e) Tell me about how you get that.
- (f) What do you want to share more about your birth?

Ending Questions

- (a) Tell me, for you, what was the most important about your birth experience?
- (b) Is there anything you would like to ask me?
