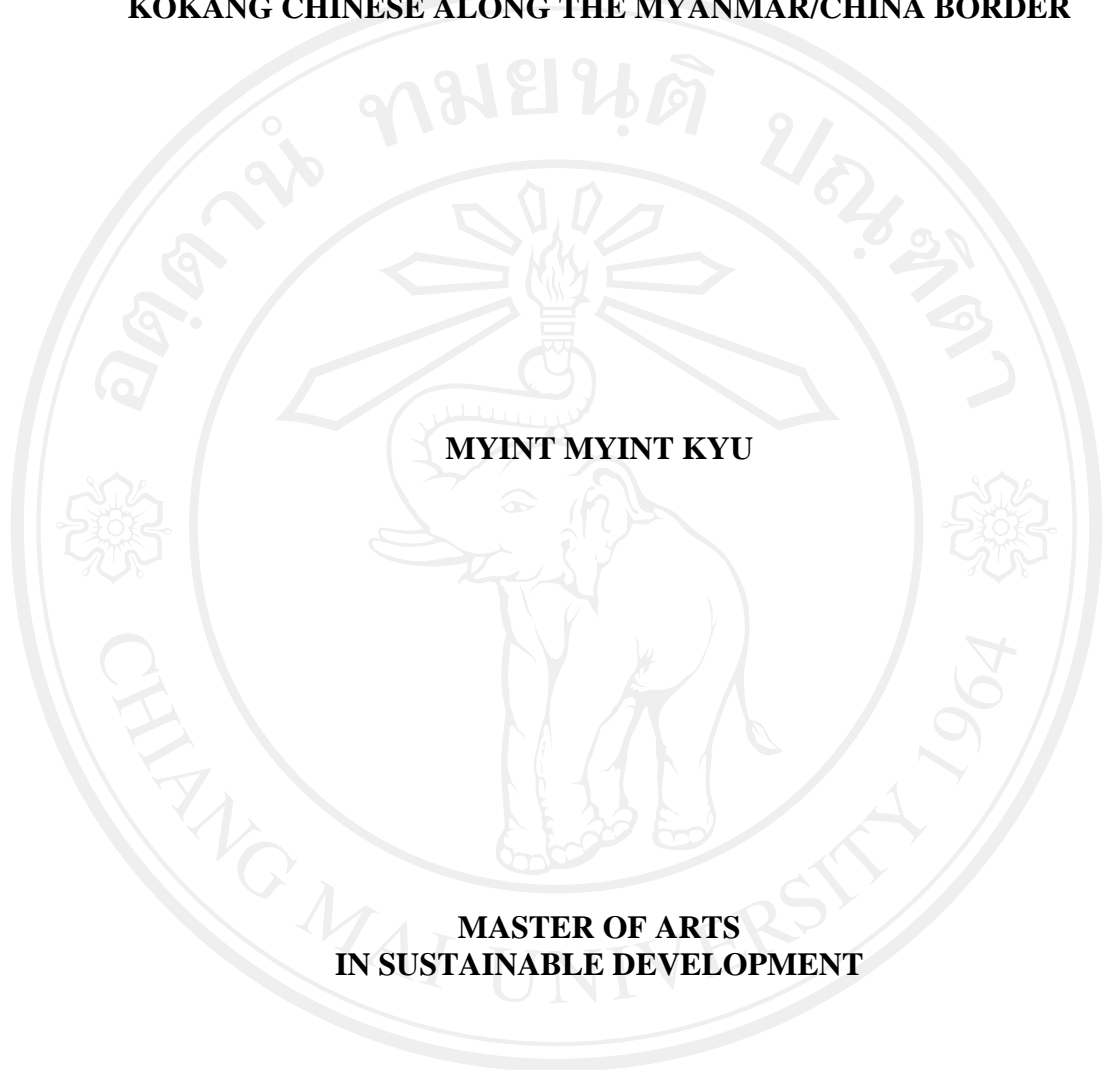

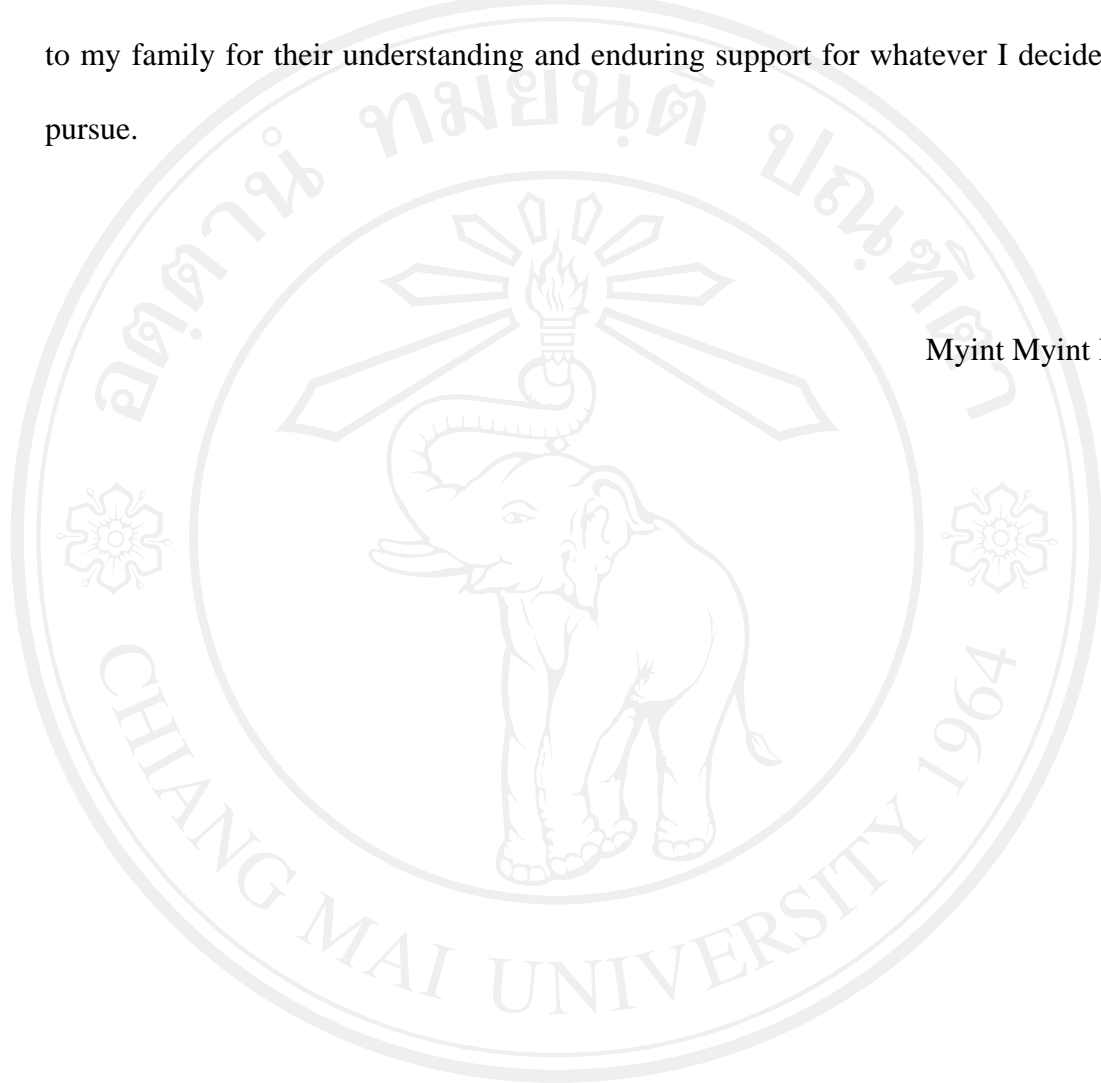
ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS
